30 Days of Grace

As you read this letter, we are now in God's 30-day grace period for sowing your Sukkot First Fruits offering. If you haven't been able to give until now, or want to increase your offering, there is still time. This special window of blessing is still open! (See Numbers 9)

Ancient Jewish wisdom explains that there are three “**appointed times**” each year when God opens the “**windows of Heaven.**” He promises to pour out “such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it.” (Malachi 3:10)

These windows are only open during Passover (Pesach), Pentecost (Shavuot) and Sukkot (Feast of Tabernacles). These biblical holidays are when God calls us to respond with a First Fruits offering. (See Deuteronomy 16:16)

Each one is a unique time of sowing and reaping. Your part is to sow. God's part is to bring in the miracle harvest . . . best of all, it's already pre-planned. Look at how the Message Bible teaches this:

*Don't be misled: No one makes a fool of God.
What a person plants, he will harvest.
The person who plants selfishness, ignoring the needs
of others — ignoring God! — harvests a crop of weeds.
All he'll have to show for his life is weeds!
But the one who plants in response to God,
letting God's Spirit do the growth work in him,
harvests a crop of real life, eternal life.*

GALATIANS 6:7-8

There's a powerful spiritual principle from the prophet Isaiah that shows you just how valuable it is to be involved with consistent giving.

*...And His own righteousness, it sustained Him.
For He put on righteousness as a breastplate...*

ISAIAH 59:16-17

The great Jewish sages teach that God sees each act of kindness as individual metal scales. Together they form the breastplate of righteousness. Over a lifetime, each "mitzvah" (act of kindness) joins together to form a shield of protection that covers your heart and protects your life.


