Dear Friend,

Tiz and I want to wish you and yours a very Merry Christmas and a Happy Chanukah!

We also want you to know just how much we've appreciated all your help this year with supporting our charitable projects in Israel.

Because of you, we have been able to bless thousands of Jewish people in desperate need. On behalf of all of them, we say "thank you" for saving their lives and giving them hope for a better future.

A few weeks ago, **friends and government officials from Israel paid us a visit** on a Sunday here at the Dallas church. (Come visit us yourself when you can on a First Fruits or miracle service. I promise you won't be disappointed.)

They came to personally thank our congregation and stream church family for our support of Project Aliyah. Our one-year donation of \$1,000,000 was **exceedingly, abundantly over any amount they ever expected.**

At lunch I asked them to tell me what the next project could be. They immediately answered, "Saving Ethiopian Jews. Getting them home to

Israel before the government shuts the window.”

They said as many as 7,000 are praying for help to return home to Israel. However, the government has said only 1,000 can return right now. They must enter the emigration process before the end of this year.

One of the other serious problems they face is the threat of being harmed or murdered for their faith. We were told it's not only Muslims who persecute them, but it's also Christians. Needless to say, I was stunned.

How on earth could Christians be killing Jews in the name of the Prince of Peace? In the end it all has to do with replacement theology — which is the horrible doctrine that Christians have replaced the Jews in God's plans because they (the Jews) are the Christ-killers.

Let me say this right now: your support of this ministry helps us make a vocal stand against this hateful teaching. So thank you for standing with Tiz and me.

This past year — through your generous support — we've been able to help well over 1,000 Jews come home to their ancient homeland. Today, they are among friends, in safe surroundings, and have an incredible future in front of them.

So, as of that meeting, we've made the decision to begin a special Year-End Campaign. Our new goal is to help as many of these 1,000 Ethiopian mothers, fathers, sons and daughters as possible return to Israel. **Together we can give them a new beginning in the Holy Land.**

Your past support has made the dream of Aliyah possible for so many. It is the fulfillment of biblical prophecy as Isaiah says,

*Thus says the Lord God:
“Behold, I will lift My hand in an oath to the (Gentile) nations,
And set up My standard for the peoples;
They shall bring your sons in their arms,
and your daughters shall be carried on their shoulders.”*
I S A I A H 49:22

**But as we're learning, the job isn't finished.
There's more God wants us to do.**

He's asking us to step up together and get as much of this done as we possibly can. All of us need to take another step of faith together, even though we have already reached our original 2018 goal. We just don't have the money in the bank to write another check.

That's why I'm asking you to do something over and above what you've already done. Please help us raise up to \$750,000 by December 31st. The immigration costs, which includes airfare, for one person is \$750.

As you can imagine, most Ethiopians live a meager existence. Their average income is no more than \$10 a day. The fact is most just don't have the money to pay for the immigration expenses.

This is why we need your help to make it happen.

Your gift of any size toward this is so important. Without your help, I just don't know how we can get this done.


